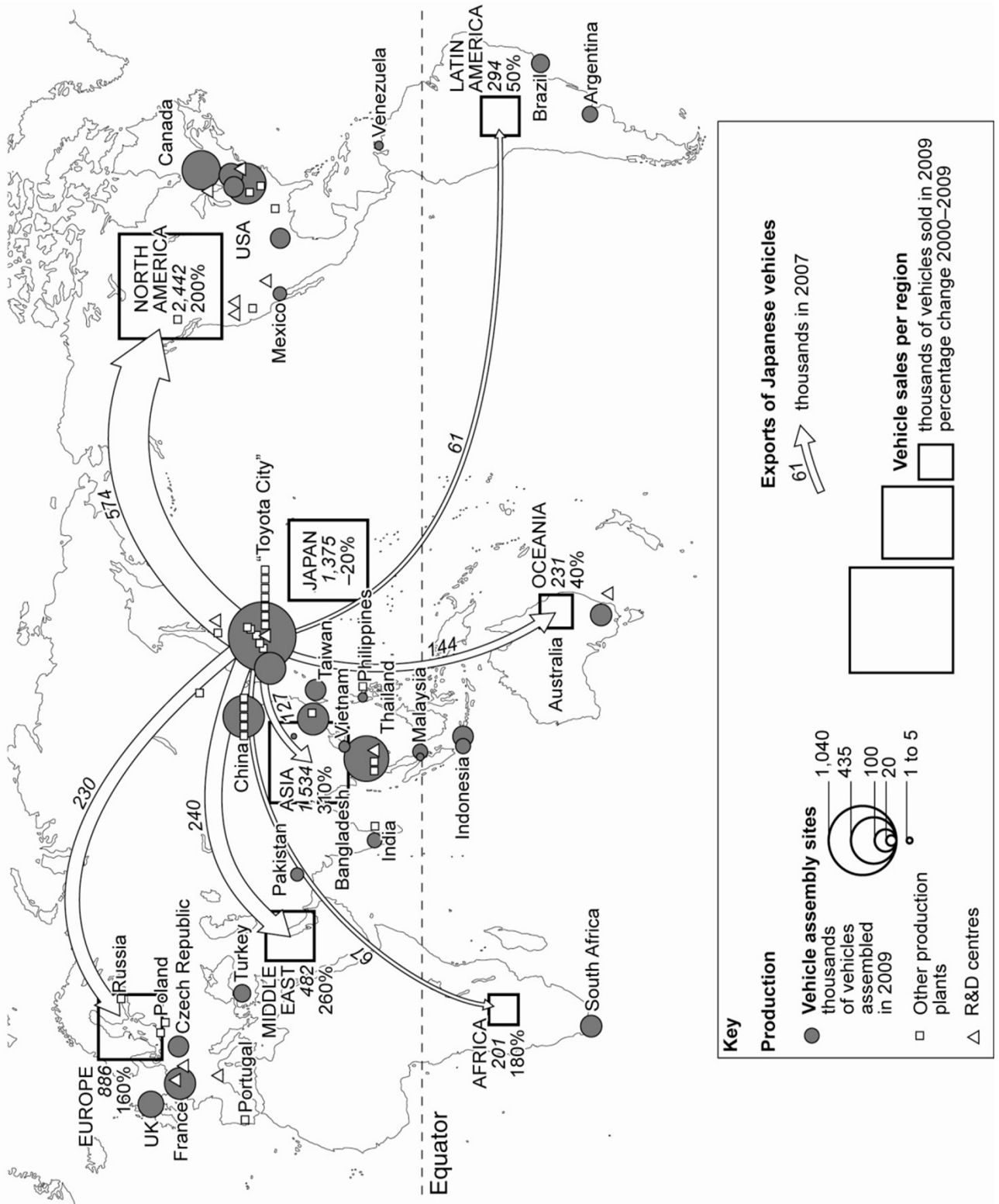

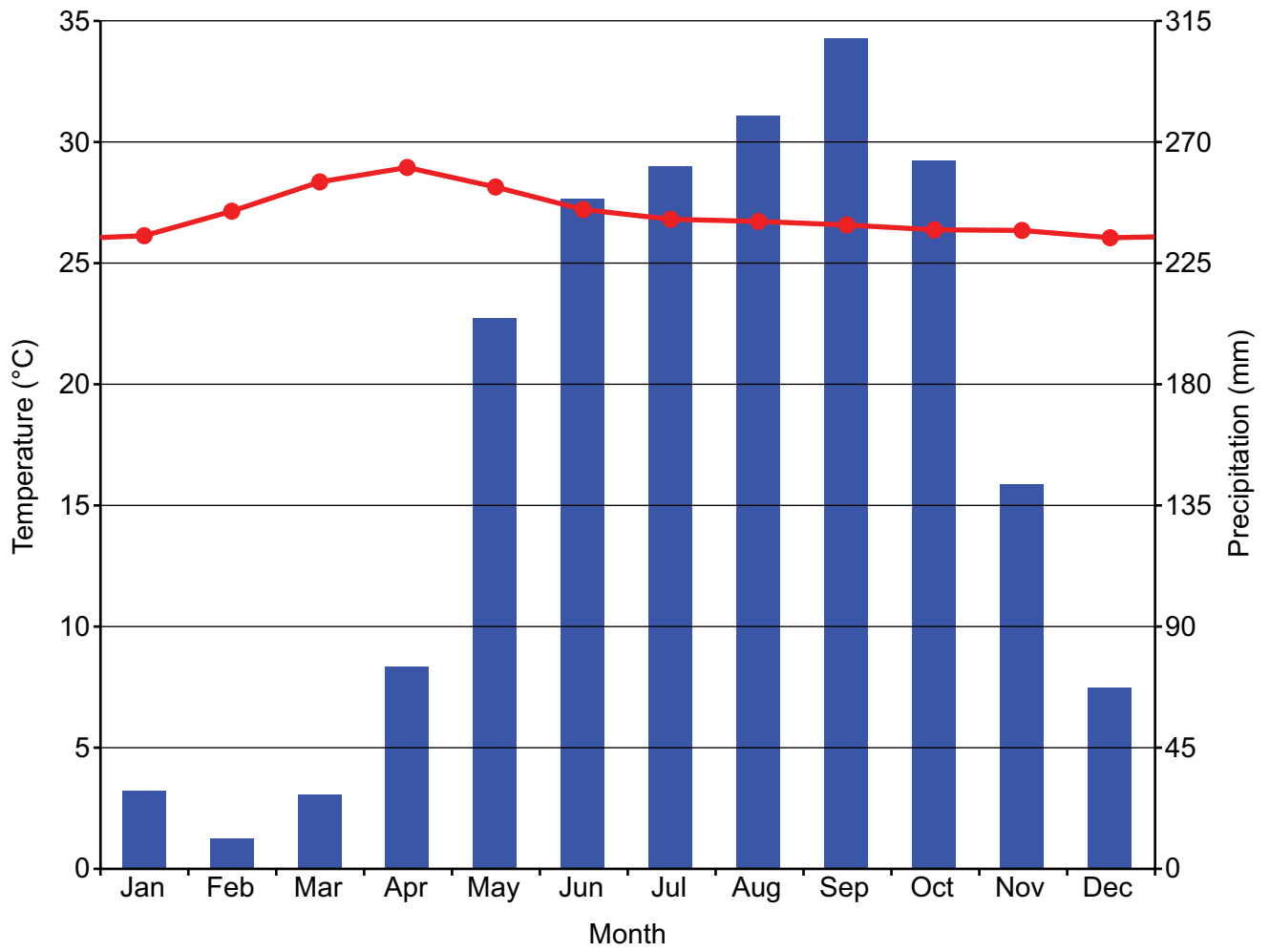

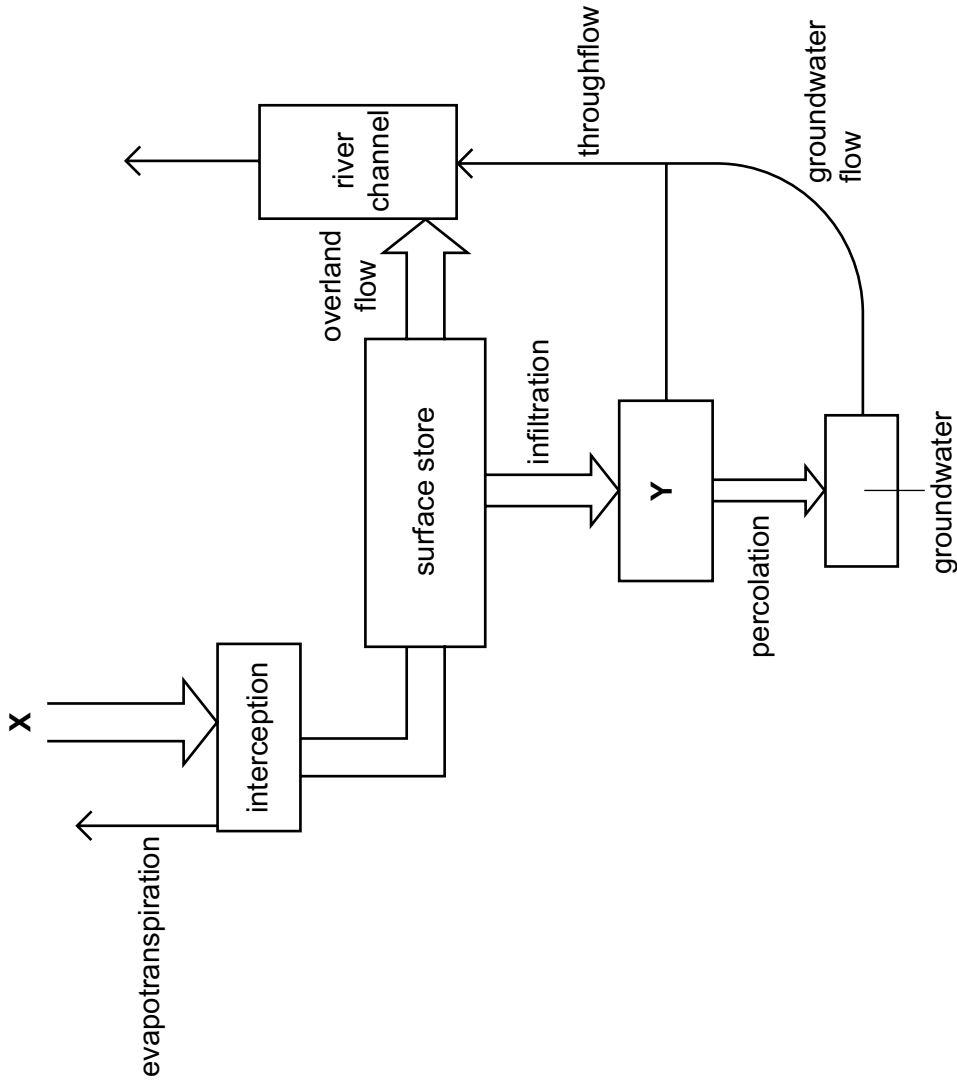

## Climate graph of Ho Chi Minh, Vietnam



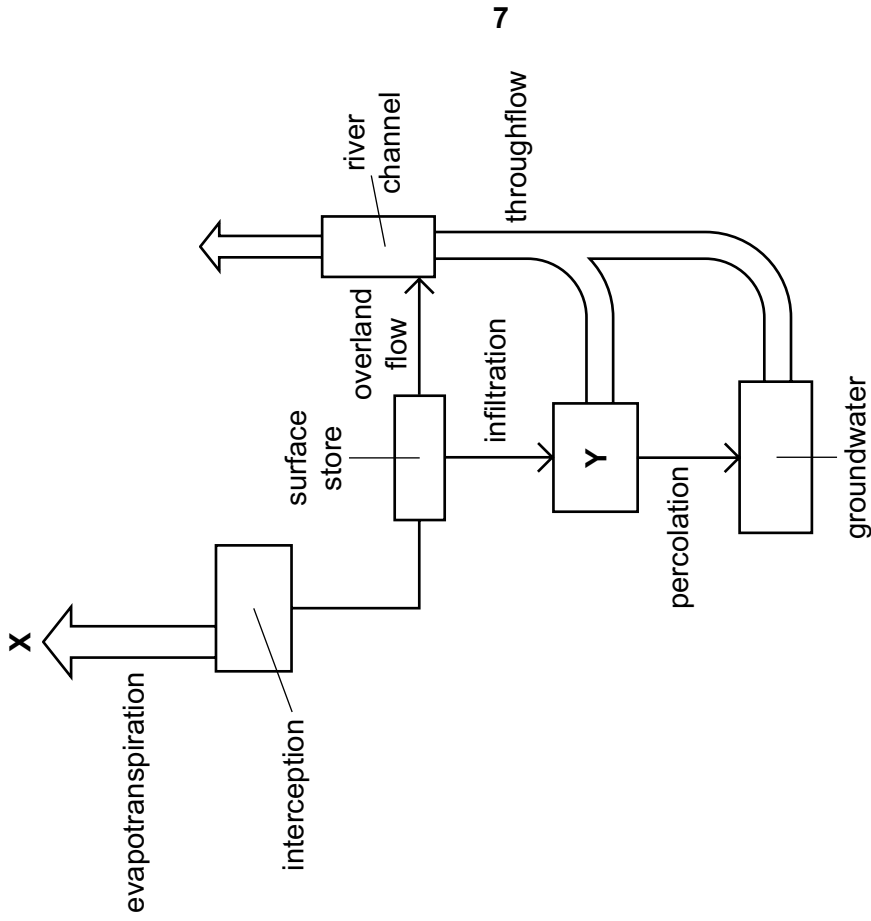

Schematic diagram of drainage basin systems in Tropical Savannah climate zone during the wet season



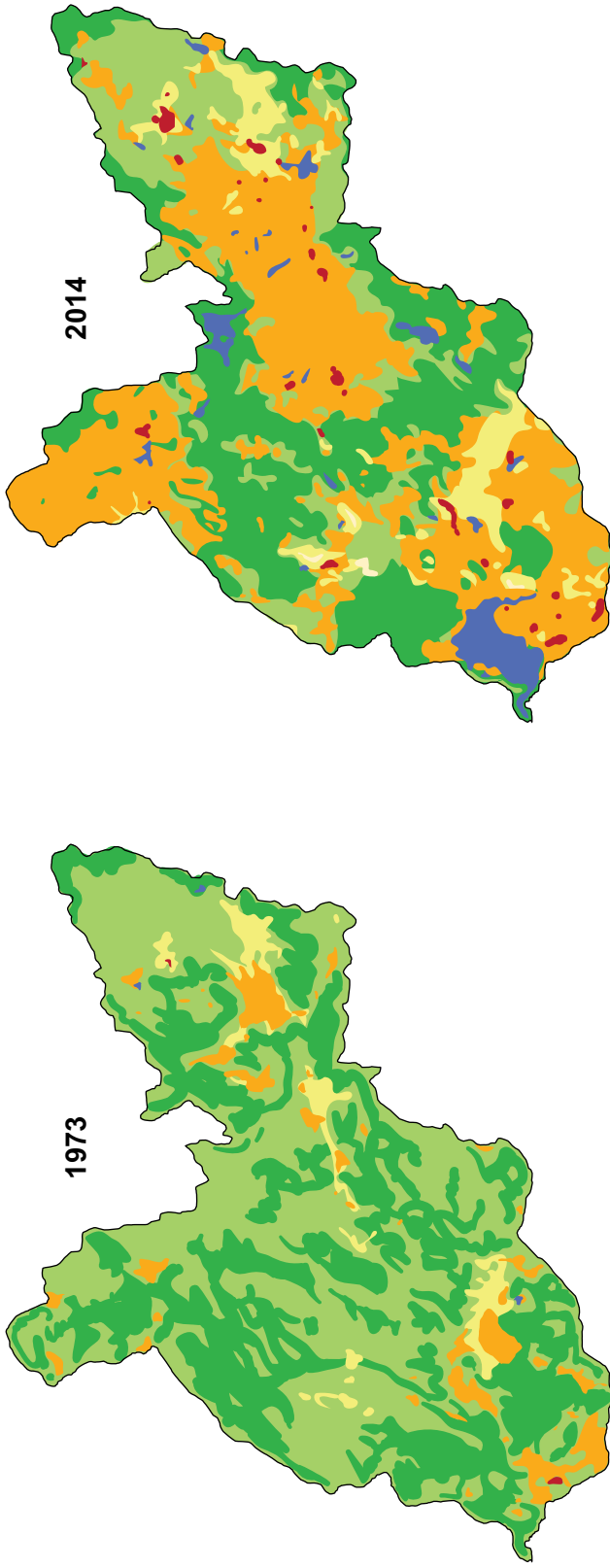

**Key**

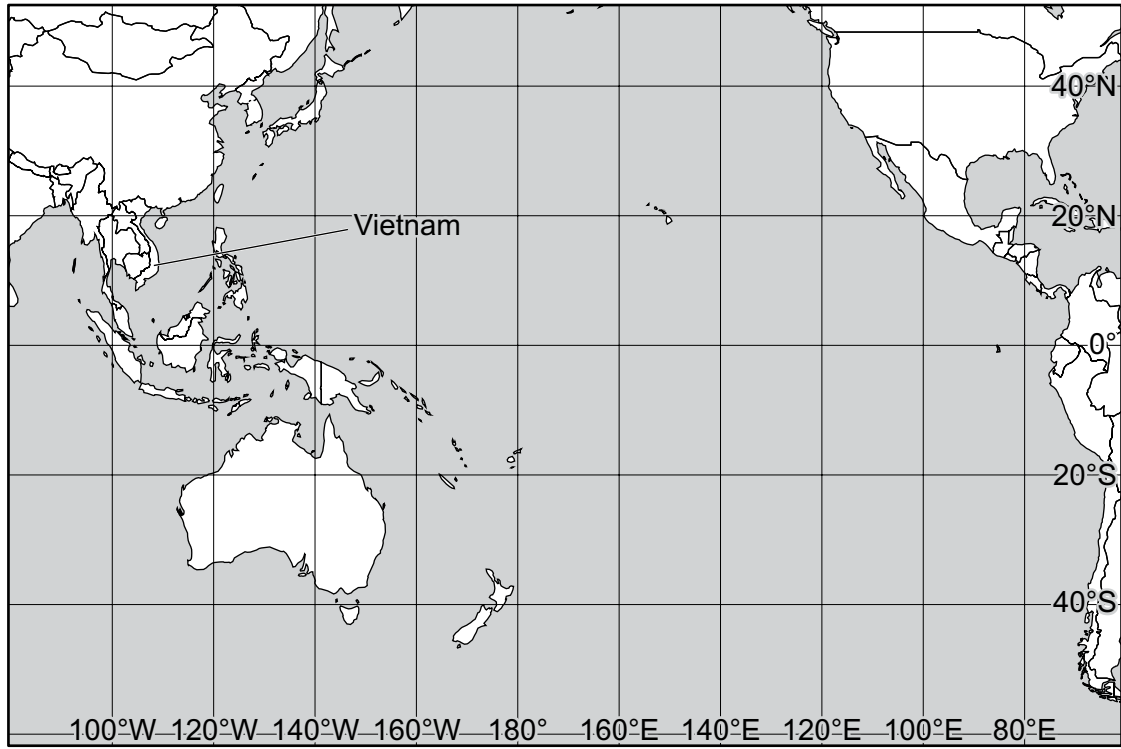
Arranged in decreasing density of land cover:

-  Orchard: areas with widely and evenly spaced fruit trees
-  Crop land: areas for crop cultivation, including scattered rural settlements
-  Grasses
-  Built-up residential area
-  Water bodies: lakes, reservoirs, rivers
