EXPLANATORY NOTES

- The Singapore Examinations and Assessment Board (SEAB) is authorised by the Republic of Singapore to manage national examinations in Singapore. The Board, together with the Ministry of Education (MOE), Singapore and Cambridge International Education are the joint examining authorities for the General Certificate of Education Normal (Academic) Level (GCE N(A)-Level) Examination.
- Where a subject is not developed by MOE / Cambridge International Education, the name of the examining agency for the subject is printed in brackets with the subject title.
- The grades for GCE N(A)-Level subjects are 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 (Grade 1 is the highest grade and Grade 6 the lowest). Grade 6 denotes that the candidate's performance has not met the minimum requirements of the subject. 'ABSENT' denotes that the candidate is absent or has withdrawn from the subject.
- 4 Performance in the Oral / Aural Examination in Chinese, Malay and Tamil is indicated as Distinction, Merit, Pass or Ungraded.
- The symbol 'T' is used to denote that no grade was awarded to the candidate because of irregularities.
- Where appropriate, subjects are annotated with the following symbols:

The candidate was exempted from satisfying the full range of assessment objectives in the papers sat for this subject.

+ Access Arrangement Symbol

The candidate sat for the paper under access arrangements.

E* Symbol

The candidate was exempted from the Oral and / or Listening Comprehension component due to valid reasons.
